Aguas de Sanidad Ministry Center Opens in Buenos Aires, Argentina!

Many thanks to the hundreds of people who joined us as “Square Foot Sponsors” and helped us realize our goal of opening the Aguas de Sanidad Ministry Center in downtown Buenos Aires! We leased the building in December, and with your help, we were able to immediately do the renovations that were needed!

We moved in to the Center in late January and things moved into high gear in February. We are sharing space with the Pablo Besson Foundation (whose founder is our friend & regular Aguas conference participant, Malena Manzato). Malena and her team help oversee long-term care & follow-up to those who are impacted in our events & services.

God has been doing amazing things in the lives of the members of the small groups that are now meeting weekly in the Center! Small groups for battered women, sexually abused teens & pre-teens, violent men seeking change—it’s a hub of ministry activity! We also partner with Malena’s foundation in offering several different Biblically based study courses at the Center...including subjects such as “Masculinity”, “Gender Identity”, “Prevention”, etc.

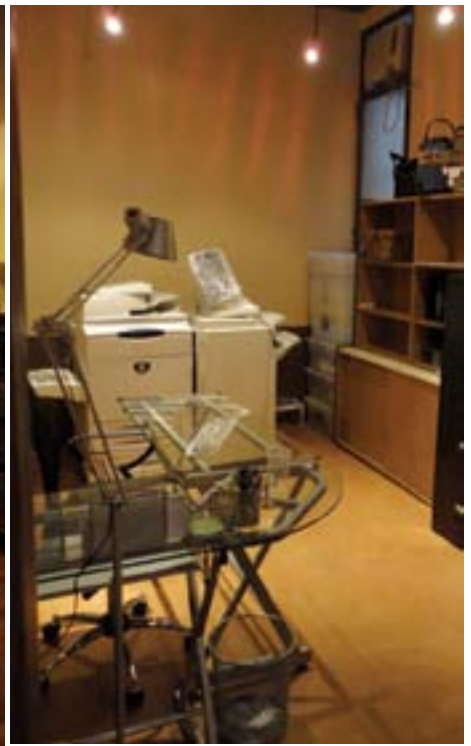
The voluntary team of professionals that work in the Center is an Interdisciplinary team—as well as interdenominational! It’s truly amazing how God has brought us all together. Breaking the Silence! in Italy & Spain

In February, part of our team (Graciela and I) spent the entire month ministering in Italy & Spain. **We were involved in 3 events that were titled after our Aguas events: "BREAKING THE SILENCE!"** It's amazing to see God raising up this same vision in other countries through what He has done here in Argentina! We had the opportunity to work alongside Argentine A/G Missionary to Italy, Margarita Macazaga, the organizer of the events.

The events took place in Barcelona, Spain; Milan, Italy; and Rome, Italy. I could hardly believe I was there preaching and ministering in those historic places—**ministering in Rome was surreal** (in the event, and then afterwards in a local church in downtown Rome)—thinking that Paul himself had walked some of those same places...unbelievable. And...powerful moves of the Holy Spirit!

During our month of ministry, there were moments of incredibly intense spiritual warfare—the entire trip was a lesson in spiritual warfare—but the Lord accomplished great things as we pressed on through in prayer.

Let me share just one powerful testimony that happened as a result of the event in Barcelona.

Isabella (not her real name) and her parents were sent to the event by their home church in Galicia—

the pastors/church covered the cost of the trip for them, knowing their desperate need to be ministered to.

Isabella is 15 years old. Her parents brought her to the event in the hopes that, as a family, they could be restored. You see, all during her childhood Isabella was being sexually violated by her father. (Her own biological father—who was there at the event with her). As we started the opening session that morning, we began like all of our other events—by breaking the silence over the taboo subjects of sexual abuse, family violence, and the devastation left behind when undealt with. I always minister the opening service by sharing my own testimony. As we moved into the ministry time, Isabella's father was weeping openly...he first approached me, saying that his daughter needed help—then, finally, he admitted the awful truth of 'why'. Isabella's mother also came to grips that day with the horrific reality and gravity of what had gone on for years in the home. It was not an easy morning for her. But of the three of them, Isabella was the one who was touched most deeply. She wept openly, as she began taking her first steps towards deliverance, healing, and restoration. Just this past week, we heard that Isabella continues to have great breakthroughs in her journey to healing!

Government Workers' prayer group

Recently we started a new evangelistic outreach. We are hosting a prayer meeting at the Center for people who work within the government. We invite them to come, ask them to bring their prayer requests and we pray for them. Plus, we don't miss the chance to share a short word from the Word!

This past week we had about 10 people there, none of whom had a relationship with the Lord. I shared a word that I've been preaching a lot this year...a teaching about spiritual inheritance—and how we can completely change the history of our family through confronting the 'strongman' (Matt. 12:29), breaking from generational strongholds by applying the blood over our lives and household. The Holy Spirit helped me as I shared.

For *Robert and Elisa (*not their real names), this was the first time they have attended a meeting like this. He is a construction company owner, and she is an attorney who has had a close relationship with the president of the nation. Here they sat—in the Aguas Center—listening intently to the Word. During the prayer time, I cheated and opened my eyes. I was surprised to see them both praying along and agreeing out loud to what we were praying. After the meeting he came to me and began to tell me of the abuse that he'd suffered and the resulting stronghold it's had in his life all of these years. About two years ago, his wife, Elisa, fell into a deep clinical depression. She has struggled just to get up and breathe every day. She called us a couple of days later to tell us how they, as a couple, have been meditating on the Word and how they sense a change in their lives, even in the atmosphere in their home. SO AWESOME!

Another lady in the group requested prayer for her son who had left her to live with his father. His father is heavily involved in occult practices. She wanted us to pray that her son would choose not to involve himself further and return home to her. So we prayed. We bound the strongman. THE NEXT DAY SHE CALLED TO TELL US THAT HER SON HAD SUDDENLY RETURNED HOME! Praise the Lord!

Another government worker that was in attendance was so impacted

by the teaching that the next day on her break she was sharing it with the rest of her coworkers at the her office. One of them said, "My friend Silvina needs to hear this!" She contacted her friend and Silvina, in turn, contacted the Center and made an appointment. In the session with her, she told of the traumatic events that have marked their home & family. Her husband had committed suicide the day his first grandchild was born...freak accidents and violence have marked the history of this family.

Silvina arrived at the Ministry Center desperate for answers.

Our team ministered to her...shared the Word with her. They explained the authority of the blood of Jesus and the work of the cross regarding sin and Satan's power to destroy and devastate—even generationally. She opened her heart up right there—surrendered her life to God. She took authority over her children's SPIRITUAL INHERITANCE by applying the blood of Jesus to her own life and claiming its benefits for her and the lives of her children and grandchildren. She began a brand new life in Christ just days ago.

We continue to minister to her, and she AND her children are going to begin attending the prayer meeting!

Leading the March! No to Violence Against Women

Aguas de Sanidad and Malena's Pablo Besson Foundation helped lead the way for what has turned into a national march campaign against violence against women! Malena, specifically, gave incredible leadership for this event.

The first march started in the Aguas Ministry Center and saw over 200 people involved. The clothing you see being displayed represent the almost 300 women who died at the hands of their husbands or boy-friends in domestic violence incidents last year alone. The sign reads "They will never be able to use these clothes again!" Many of the articles of clothing were torn, some burned, represented the horrific ways that many of these precious women lost their lives.

We were overwhelmed to be met by ALL OF THE MAJOR MEDIA outlets

of the nation! Every news channel had their satellite trucks out at the Obelisk waiting for us when we arrived. Our Speed-The-Light printer printed up thousands of brochures that were passed out to passersby and cars waiting at the intersections. Some of the major social justice players in the legal system were also on-hand. Three judges came and signed their names on the signs that said "NO" to domestic violence and YES to women and children's right to live in safety & peace.

This march was an effort put together by dozens of organizations, but we were so proud not only to participate, but to host the organizational part of it at the Aguas Center.

The campaign will continue monthly in different sectors of the city, and then culminate in a nationally organized march (one in the capital of every province in the nation) in November in recognition of the "International Elimination of Violence Against Women's Day".
